Originally built as a transatlantic liner and beautifully restored and maintained as a premium-rated cruise ship, *Astoria* offers all the comforts, convenience and the warm welcome that is the hallmark of all CMV operations. *Astoria* is a perfect home from home, both small enough to offer an intimate, friendly atmosphere, and large enough to offer a relaxed environment to ensure your holiday enjoyment.

Astoria's short season of cruises from Bristol in early 2016 includes a trio of UK waters cruises calling at some of our remoter outposts, a 'south to the springtime sun' sailing down to the islands of the Azores, and a marvellous voyage to glorious Western Norway, seen at its best in late spring.

Fully stabilised and air-conditioned, Portuguese-registered *Astoria* offers well appointed public areas and comfortable cabins arranged on eight passenger decks served by two lifts and wide stairwells.

The ship boasts an elegant marbled reception, a stylish, two-sectioned restaurant, alternative buffet dining, and a choice of five other lounges and bars, including the a main show room.

Smaller and more intimate than her fleet-mates, *Astoria* offers a wonderful range of on-board amenities, as well as plenty of places in which to find a quiet corner to curl up with a book, or to rest and relax, especially during days at sea.

With the emphasis on warm and friendly cruising, there's always something happening, arranged by the Cruise Director and the team, and published in the daily bulletin. Whether it's a light-hearted quiz, a port lecture, an exercise class or dance instruction, should you wish to join with your fellow passengers, there is no shortage of choices with which to occupy your time – and that's all before you've stepped ashore to explore – either under your own steam, or on an organised shore excursion.

When evening comes, *Astoria's* restaurant, lounges and bars put on another cloak, as the ship becomes a warm intimate home from home.

Dining on *Astoria* – always a pleasure!

As you would expect from a cruise holiday where the accent is on the traditional, dining on board *Astoria* will invariably be one of the high points of the day, even if all your resolutions about calories and exercise are broken the minute you sit down!

The traditional two-sectioned *Olissipo Restaurant* offers delicious fare at lunchtime and in the evenings, while the *Lotus Lounge* offers alternative buffet dining. Expect to be looked after by friendly, attentive waiters

who, together with the ship's chefs, do their very best to ensure each meal is a special experience – with 'Healthy Choices' for the calorie-conscious.

Wherever you choose to eat, you can accompany your meal with a selection from the ship's extensive and reasonably priced wine list. During each cruise there will be a Captain's Welcome and Farewell Party, as well as other themed dinners, when the menus will reflect the cuisine of the day's port of call.

Of course, all meals on board *Astoria*, including morning coffee and afternoon tea and cakes, are included in the great value cruise prices.



First-class Entertainment

Night-time entertainment is focused on the *Calypso Lounge*, where you are treated each evening to a glittering performance by the ship's troupe. Sit back as the talented team of singers and dancers entertains you with some first class cabaret and floorshows. *Astoria* boasts no less than four other bars and lounges, so whether it's sophistication in the *Sirenes* piano bar, a quiet night-cap in the *Aeolos* bar, or the beat of the disco in *Muses* night club, there's something for all tastes until you retire, perhaps after a final 'turn on the deck'.

Your floating home... ... from home!

On any cruise, especially those of more than a few days' duration, you'll want to be assured that your chosen cabin is much more than a 'bed for the night', and that you can look forward to a good night's sleep and some 'home-from-home comforts'.

The wide range of cabins on board *Astoria* offers accommodation to suit all pockets and preferences. All passenger cabins offer private facilities with shower and bath, a TV, a hairdryer and personal safe. Superior and Deluxe cabins and Suites offer extra touches such as minibar/fridge, bathrobes and slippers and even champagne on embarkation. Outside cabins offer picture windows and portholes.

Cabins have a variety of twin and double beds, with upper berths for three and 'friendly four' sharing passengers. Outside cabins also offer porthole or larger windows.
